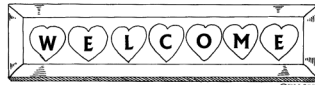

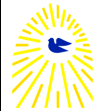

Blessing of little children and babies will be held at the end of all Masses this weekend.

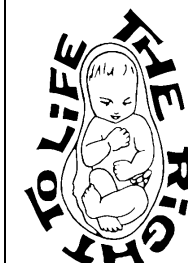
